The Lutter's owned a local brick company, which produced a distinctive buff-yellow color used widely in Chicago construction. The many fine details, particularly gracing the tower entry, evoke various popular styles from the turn of the last century, including variations of Gothic Revival and Queen Anne. While shaded by the tall trees, the stone quoins catch your eye; but the roofline ornaments, decorated gable and stained glass windows warrant much further attention.
